

Student Survey 2020 Butler County Results

Survey Methodology

- Modified version Pride Surveys' questionnaire.
- Administered every two years 11th cycle since 2000
- Both online and paper versions.
- 38,753 seventh through twelfth grade students from 77 schools completed the survey.
- In Butler County, there were 12,281 surveys completed, collected between October 1, 2019 and February 25, 2020



Definitions

- Alcohol: Beer; Liquor; Coolers, hard lemonade, etc.
- Tobacco: Cigarettes; Smokeless Tobacco; Cigars
- Marijuana: Weed, Chronic, Dank, etc.
- **Prescription Drugs:** Pain medication; Stimulant; Sleeping medication; Sedative/Anxiety
- **E-vapor:** Electronic Vapor Product, E-cigarettes, Vaping Pens, E-cigars, E-pipes, Vape pipes, E-Hookah, Hookah Pens, etc.




Prevalence of Use

2020 Student Survey	During the past 30-Days
Electronic-Vapor	14.1%
Alcohol	12.2%
Marijuana	10.2%
Cigarettes	3.2%
Prescription Drugs	3.1%



30-Day Use of Alcohol, Cigarettes, Marijuana, Prescription Drugs and Vaping




Perception of Harm

2020 Student Survey	Harmful/Very Harmful
Alcohol	76.3%
Tobacco	85.1%
Marijuana	58.6%
Prescription Drugs	83.4%
Electronic-Vapor	66.9%



Perception of Harm






Perception of Parental Disapproval

2020 Student Survey	Wrong/Very Wrong
Alcohol	86.1%
Cigarettes/Tobacco	93.6%
Marijuana	87.8%
Prescription Drugs	94.3%
Electronic-Vapor	90.7%



Perception of Parental Disapproval





Alcohol	63.7%
Cigarettes/Tobacco	79.7%
Marijuana	65.4%
Prescription Drugs	85.8%
Electronic-Vapor	64.7%



Perception of Friend Disapproval






Perception of Availability

2020 Student Survey	Fairly Easy/Very Easy
Alcohol	36.2%
Cigarettes/Tobacco	32.3%
Marijuana	30.4%
Prescription Drugs	23.4%
Electronic-Vapor	39.1%
