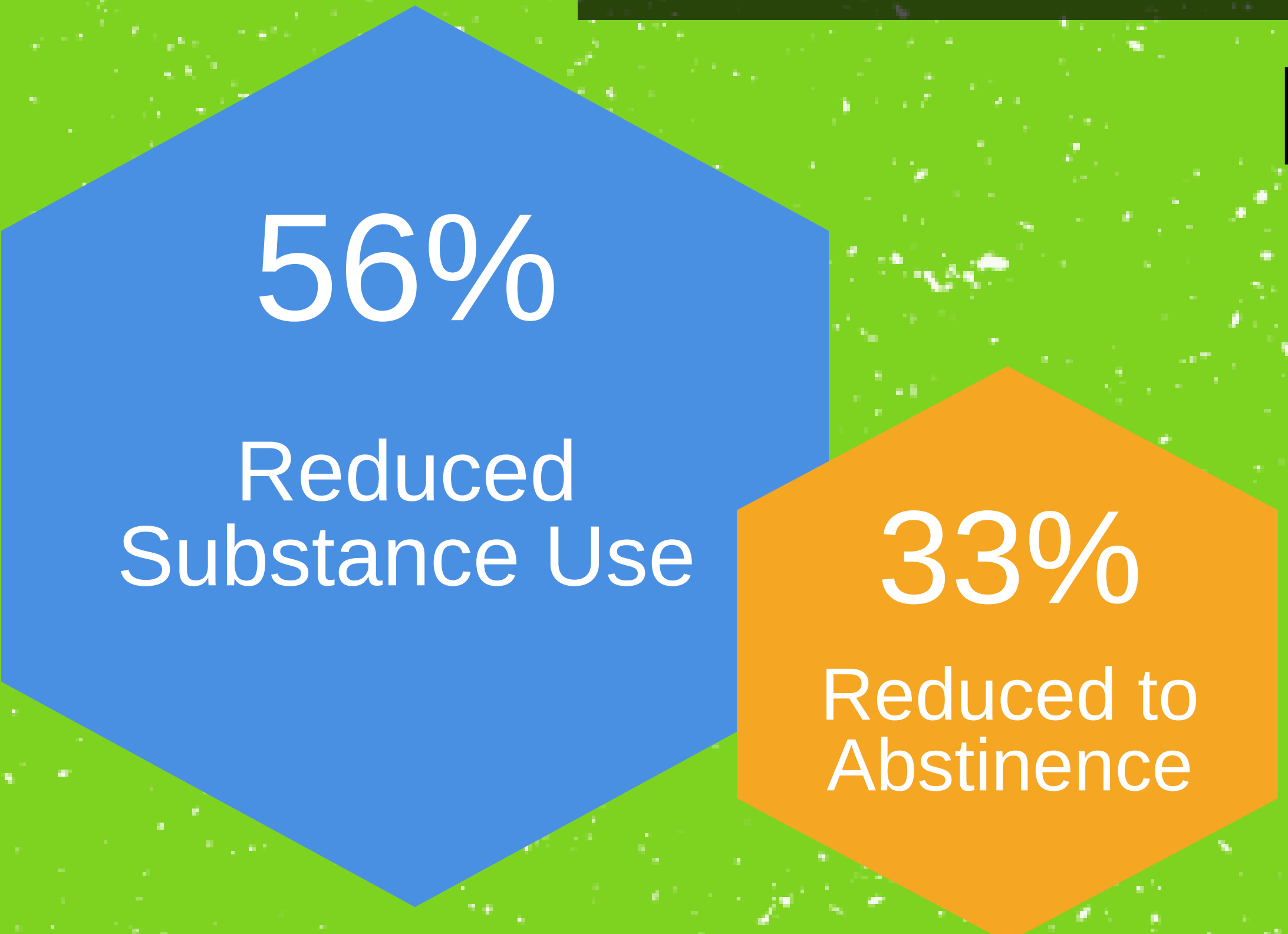

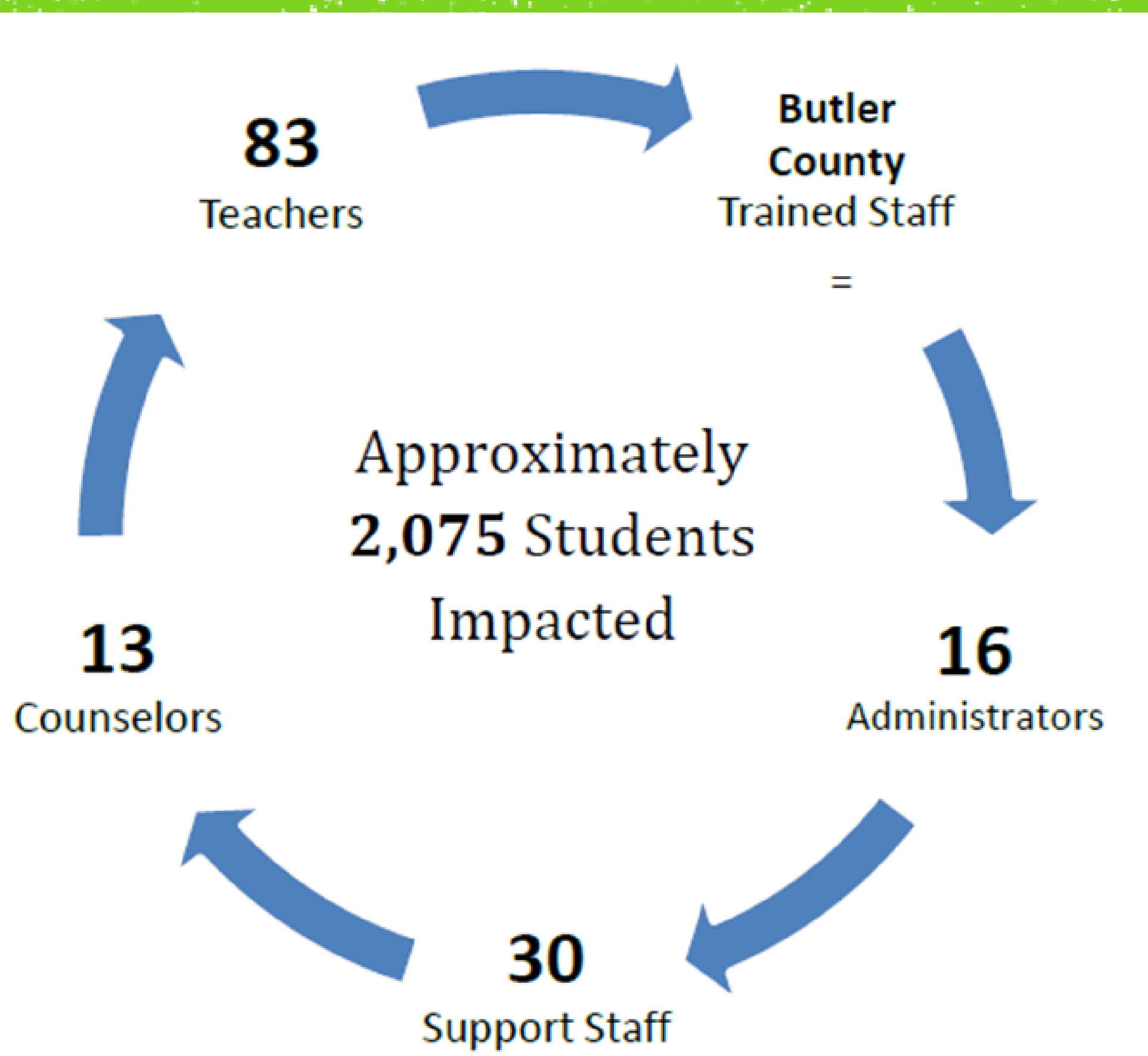
Prevention Education Support Groups



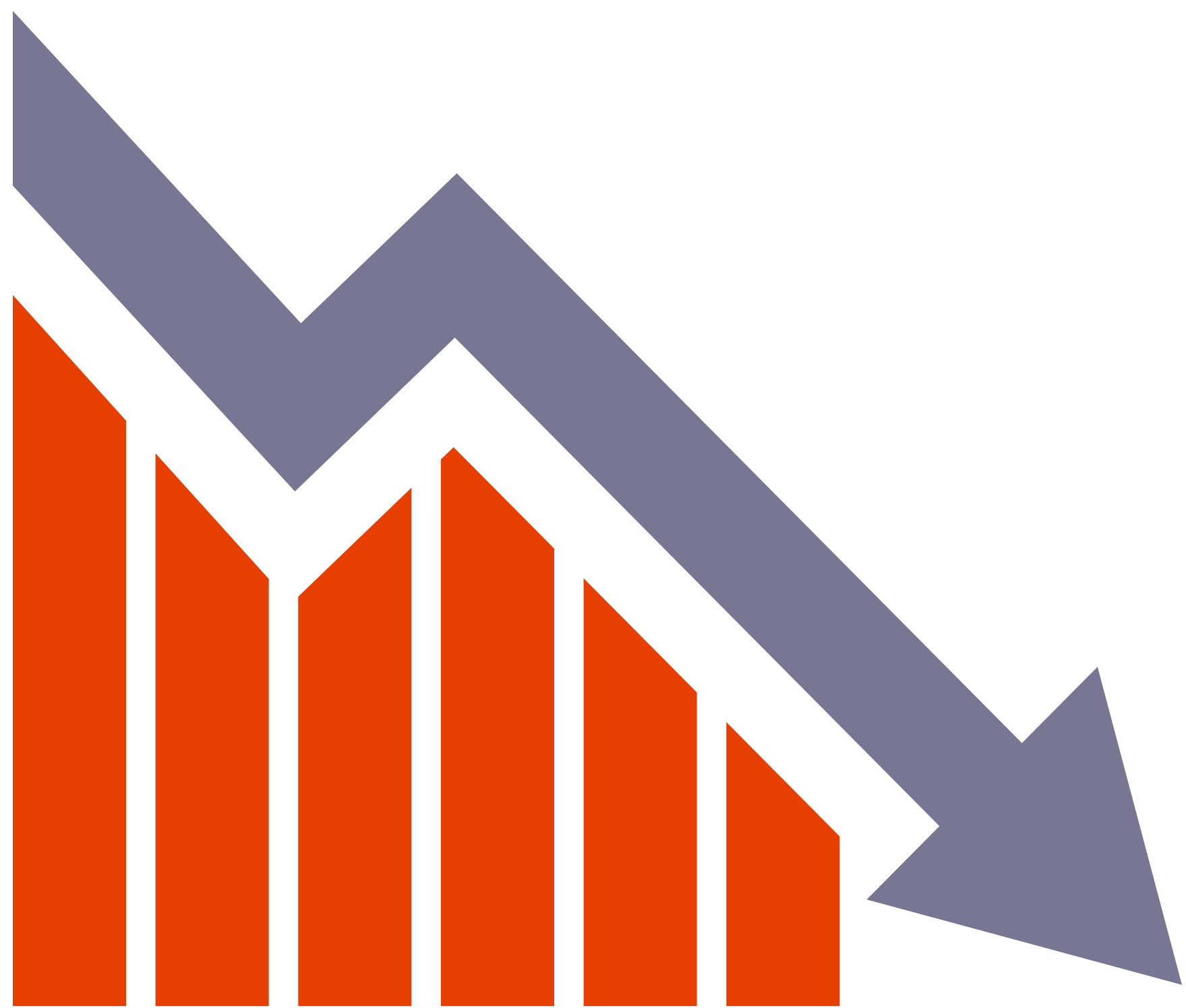
Prevention Education Support Groups facilitate life skills that assist students by enhancing their school, peer and family interactions. Small group meetings provide an individualized approach to learning and practicing essential skills for social and academic success.

*Based on 256 youth in educational support groups who reported using alcohol and other drugs.

PAX Good Behavior Game



The PAX Good Behavior Game is an evidence-based practice used by teachers and their students. PAX utilizes behavioral health strategies to improve classroom behavior and academics by boosting self-regulation.



Total number of behavioral referrals went down 31.5% with PAX.

Baby & Me Tobacco Free Program



This year we more than doubled the # of clients enrolled and had five moms and one partner complete the program to 12 months postpartum!

Suicide Prevention



272 people were trained in QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer) by our staff.

15% of the 1,552 youth that received the Signs of Suicide/Lifelines curriculum had decreased feelings of sadness or being depressed.

Percentage of adults that reported intent to use info to make low-risk gambling decisions in the future.

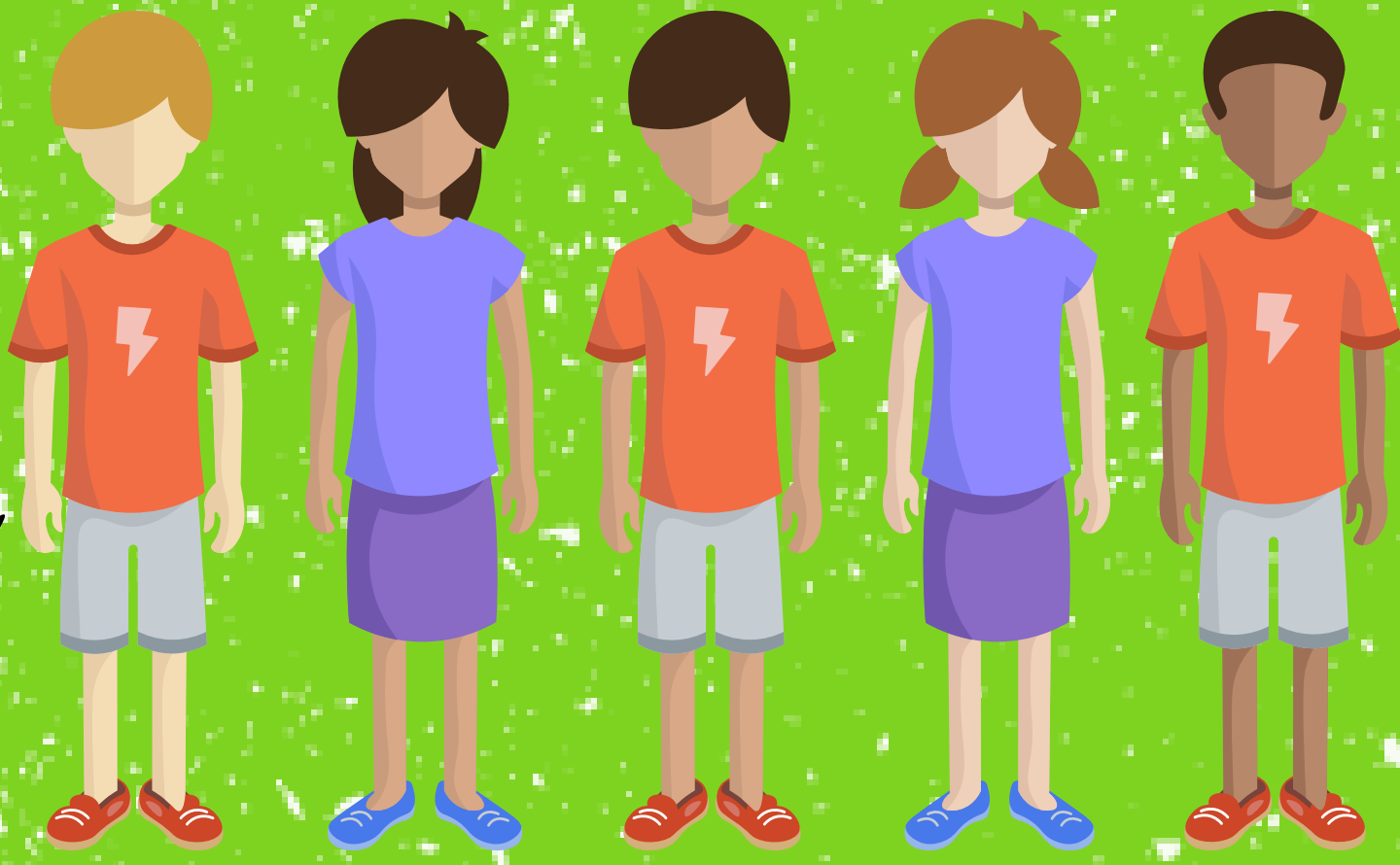


Percentage of students that reported that they have continued not to gamble.

Tobacco Policy Coalition



Tobacco 21 Passed in Ohio

While purchase age of tobacco products in Ohio was increased to 21 this year, the Butler County Tobacco Policy Coalition is continuing to work on changes to retail sales.

In 2018, 1 in 5 High School students reported using E-Cigarettes; 1 in 20 Middle School students reported use. **Notes from the Field: Use of Electronic Cigarettes and Any Tobacco Product Among Middle and High School Students*

A Low-Risk Alcohol Program for Adults



98% stated that they intend to make low-risk drinking choices in the future.



83% stated that they'd tell someone else about the low-risk guidelines.

90% stated that they gained knowledge about the low-risk guidelines.



57% stated that they gained knowledge about the standard drink definition.

June 2-15, 2019

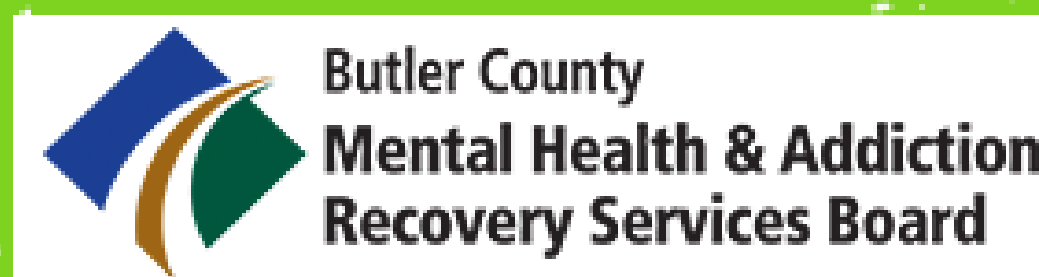
